
The integration of your presentation into our leadership development program was a perfect fit and an impressively impactful way to us to end 2017 in a positive and memorable way.

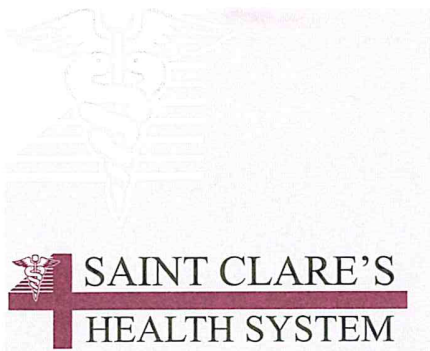
